By car

Navigation

Please note: your navigation system might not recognise the address Wilhelminakade 1. In that case you can set your destination to Stieltjesstraat, which is right next to the visitors' entrance of the car park.

From Amsterdam/Utrecht (A13/A20)

Take the A13 > A20 > A16 towards Dordrecht, cross the Van Brienoord bridge, take exit 24 (Feyenoord), follow the signs for Feyenoord, then Kop van Zuid, and Erasmusbrug.

At the end of Laan op Zuid, you can see the Maastoren on the right. Turn right before the building. You can enter the parking garage on the left. If you are registered as a visitor, you may enter the underground parking (turn right inside the parking garage).

From Nijmegen/Breda (A16)

At the Ridderkerk-Noord junction, take the A16 towards Ring Rotterdam/Den Haag. Before the Van Brienoord Bridge, take the N210 parallel lane. Take exit 24 (Feyenoord), then follow the signs for Feyenoord, then Kop van Zuid, and Erasmusbrug.

At the end of Laan op Zuid, you can see the Maastoren on the right. Turn right before the building. You can enter the parking garage on the left. If you are registered as a visitor, you may enter the underground parking (turn right inside the parking garage).

From Zierikzee / Roosendaal

Take the A29 towards Rotterdam; follow the signs towards Centrum, then Ikazia and then Erasmusbrug.

At the end of the Laan op Zuid, you can see the Maastoren on the right. Turn right before the building. You can enter the parking garage on the left. If you are registered as a visitor, you may enter the underground parking (turn right inside the parking garage).

"Maastoren" parking garage

The visitor's entrance to the parking garage is located on Stieltjesstraat. Visitors are requested to report via the intercom. Upon entering the garage, there are signs to direct you to the visitors' parking spaces.

Public Transportation

Tram

Accessible via tram lines 20, 23 and 25. The Maastoren itself is a 1 minute walk from tram stop Wilhelminaplein.

Metro

Accessible via the Erasmuslijn (metro line D) heading towards Slinge and Spijkenisse. The Maastoren itself is a 1 minute walk from metro station Wilhelminaplein.

Bus

Accessible via bus 60 to Wilhelminaplein. The Maastoren itself is a 1 minute walk from the bus stop.

Water
